SOUTHWEST FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT REPORTS JUNE TRAFFIC

FORT MYERS, Fla. (July 25, 2008) – During June, more than 488,000 passengers traveled through Southwest Florida International Airport, a decrease of 7 percent compared to June 2007. Year-to-date, passenger traffic is down nearly 4.7 percent over the same period last year.

The traffic leader in June was Delta with 66,987 passengers traveling to and from Fort Myers. Rounding out the top five airlines were AirTran (58,513), Southwest (57,899), US Airways (55,040) and JetBlue (54,087).

Southwest Florida International Airport had 5,813 aircraft movements (takeoffs and landings), a decrease of 2.2 percent over June 2007. Page Field General Aviation Airport saw 5,115 movements, a 10 percent decrease over June 2007. In addition, more than 2.4 million pounds of air freight moved through both airports in June 2008.

Southwest Florida International Airport served more than 8 million passengers in 2007 and is one of the top 50 busiest U.S. airports. No ad valorem (property) taxes are used for airport operation or construction. For more information, log onto www.flyclpa.com.
